



# Your new bins

Your new set of bins will be delievered to your kerbside between now and 13 September.

They will have your address clearly marked on them (along with your collection day and zone), so please store them somewhere safe until it is time to use them when the new service changes over from Tuesday 1 October.

Everything you need to know is in a Guide and calendar, which can be found inside your new food scraps bin.

# Store them safely

Please store your new bins somewhere safe until then. Continue to use your current set of bins until your last collection at the end of September.

### What's happening with the old bins?

The bins you use now are owned by the current contractor, EnviroNZ. We are waiting for them to give us a collection pan. As soon as we know what's happening - we'll let you know. But the bins will be collected by them some time after your last collection at the end of September.

#### If in doubt - search online

We are currently developing some online tools to make the changeover easier in October. These will be available online from mid/late September.

- Collection Calendar simply search your address and it will show what bins to put out on your next two collections.
- **Item search** unsure of which bin an item of rubbish or recycling should go in? Search our database to easily find where it needs to go.
