Federated Farmers of New Zealand (**Federated Farmers**, or **FFNZ**) is appreciative of the opportunity to comment on Todd Energy Limited's (**TEL**) proposal to lodge a Plan Change Application (**the Application**) to the South Taranaki District Council (**STDC**) to remove Generic Consequence Setbacks (**Generic Setbacks**) from the South Taranaki District Plan (**STDP**).

FFNZ is a membership-based organisation with a long and proud history of representing, at all levels of government, the needs and interests of New Zealand farmers. Our members engage in activities which significantly contribute to the economic, social and cultural wellbeing of New Zealand. FFNZ is committed to advocate for farmers to enhance and uphold the value of farming. FFNZ represents approximately 491 members in the South Taranaki District and welcomes any opportunity to favourably influence policy to the benefit of our members.

FFNZ was approached by TEL to discuss whether FFNZ would support their application to the STDC. FFNZ understands that TEL are seeking the removal of Generic Setbacks from the STDP, however 'Petroleum Activity Risk Contours' (**Risk Contours**) would remain in the STDP. Based on discussions with TEL, FFNZ are aware that Generic Setbacks currently affect approximately 280 hectares (**ha**) of land neighbouring TEL assets.

Federated Farmers believes that Generic Setbacks can restrict landowners from utilising land within the setback. Federated Farmers was involved with the submissions process and Environment Court appeals for the STDP where Generic Setbacks were contested. Federated Farmers' position during the appeals process was that these setbacks were an arbitrary restriction on private landowners' rights. This was because they lacked the scientific and technical evidence to determine appropriate separation distances that would effectively address associated risk in all circumstances. Federated Farmers maintains this position. Should the Application be approved, only 10ha of land surrounding TEL assets would be restricted with the Risk Contour rules applied in the plan. Removing Generic Setbacks would adequately balance health and safety concerns with private landowners right to use their land.

Based on our understanding of TEL's proposal, FFNZ writes in support of Todd Energy's Application. Federated Farmers also acknowledges and supports eight of our members who are impacted landowners, some of whom have independently expressed their support of TEL's application.

Federated Farmers is thankful for the opportunity to support TEL on their application.

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
